While I do not have any words to help the situation, I would be remiss not to acknowledge the recent school shooting in Uvalde, TX. There cannot be any explanation to defend these acts of terror and I only hope that our elected leaders finally take action to mitigate the risks to all of us.

The community trend in COVID-19 cases finally subsided this week with a reduction in cases and hospitalizations in our region. In the past 2 weeks (since my last Update) there have been 3 Resident and 5 staff cases of COVID-19. We continue to do all that we can to protect everyone, and appreciate all of your efforts to comply with Federal and State guidelines.

We had another Career Fair Day on Wednesday, and met 21 individuals and offered positions to 10 of them! Others were invited back for second interviews. We will have another large group of new hires at the Orientation on June 13-14. Please continue to refer family and friends for our open positions.
