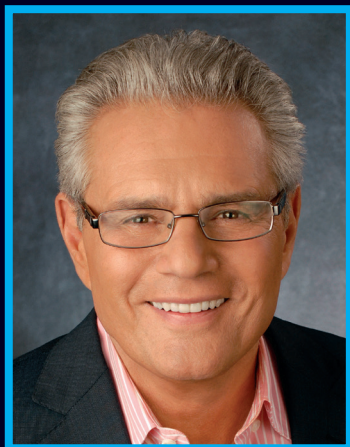

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Armen Keteyian is an 11-time Emmy Award winner, a longtime contributing correspondent to *60 Minutes* and six-time *New York Times* best-selling author, is widely recognized as one of the finest journalists of his generation and a highly respected authority on the most pressing issues in the world of sport.

Most recently, Keteyian was the anchor and executive producer for *The Athletic*. Prior to joining *The Athletic*, he spent 12 years in various roles as a CBS News correspondent. In that capacity he was the lead correspondent for *60 Minutes Sports* and the chief investigative correspondent for *CBS News*.

Keteyian won three consecutive Emmy Awards for his reporting in the prestigious "Outstanding Investigative Journalism in a Regularly Scheduled Newscast" category for *CBS Evening News* stories.

From December 1997 to March 2006, Keteyian was a special features reporter for *CBS Sports* in New York where he roamed the sidelines at top NFL games and covered the league for *The NFL Today*. He also regularly covered the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament and anchored the network's award-winning coverage of the Tour de France. He was also a featured correspondent for HBO's *Real Sports with Bryant Gumbel*.

Prior to joining CBS and HBO, Keteyian worked as a network correspondent for *ABC News* for eight years. During that time, he wrote and reported more than 400 stories on a wide variety of sports-related issues for *World News Tonight with Peter Jennings*, *Nightline*, and other *ABC News* programs. Prior to joining *ABC News*, Keteyian worked as a writer-reporter for *Sports Illustrated*. While there he reported on subjects ranging from corruption in college football and basketball, to sports gambling in America, to point shaving scandals, to the widening use of steroids in professional and amateur sports.

Keteyian has also written or co-written 13 books, including the No.1 *New York Times* best-selling biography *Tiger Woods*. In August 2024 *The Price* was published, a behind-the-scenes look into the chaotic state of big-time college football. Most recently, Keteyian collaborated with legendary Sonny Vaccaro on his memoir *Legends and Soles*.

Keteyian began his career as a sports and feature writer in San Diego. A native of Michigan he graduated cum laude in 1976 with a BA in Journalism from San Diego State University. He lives in Fairfield with Dede, his wife of 45 years.
