

MIKE PRESSLER is a distinguished American lacrosse coach with over four decades of experience at the collegiate and professional levels. From Wilton, CT, he played, and captained both lacrosse and football at Washington and Lee University in Virginia. In 1983, Pressler launched his coaching career by becoming the inaugural head coach at Virginia Military Institute, leading the program in its very first season. He led Ohio Wesleyan University as head coach from 1986 to 1990, achieving a remarkable 69–16 record, secured four NCAC championships, and steered the team to three NCAA Division III championship game appearances.

In 1991, Pressler took the helm at Duke University, where he led the Blue Devils for 16 seasons, amassing a 153–82 record. Under his leadership, Duke won three ACC titles and reached the NCAA championship game in 2005. He was honored as the ACC Coach of the Year three times and received the USILA National Coach of the Year award in 2005.

Following Duke, Pressler served as head coach at Bryant University from 2007 to 2022, leading the Bulldogs to six NCAA tournament appearances and retiring with a 153–103 record. He guided the U.S. men's national team to World Championship gold twice, serving as an assistant in Perth, Australia in 2002, then as head coach in Manchester, England in 2010.

In 2023, Pressler was appointed head coach and general manager of Atlas Lacrosse Club in the Premier Lacrosse League. His leadership was instrumental in the team's performance during the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

Pressler serves as the varsity head coach for Highland Park, TX High School's lacrosse team. In his first season in 2023 and again in 2025, he led the team to a state championship, demonstrating his continued impact on the sport at the high school level.

Pressler is a seven-time hall of fame honoree, including Wilton High School HOF, The Connecticut High School Lacrosse HOF, Washington & Lee University HOF, Ohio Wesleyan University HOF, The Intercollegiate Men's Lacrosse Coaches Association HOF, and Bryant University HOF. Pressler lives in Dallas, TX with his family.
