ARTHUR AND GLADYS LUNIN HUMANITARIAN AWARD

Mozaic Senior Life is proud to present the Arthur and Gladys Lunin Humanitarian Award to Jim Bennett this evening, honoring his dedication to excellence within the entire community.



This award was created to recognize outstanding public and community service as exemplified by the good works of Arthur and Gladys Lunin. Any individual who by his/her sacrifice, effort, and service to the Fairfield County Community

deserves to be recognized and held up as an example for others to follow. Of special merit are those individuals who have furthered the cause of justice, fostered understanding between Jews and non-Jews, and made voluntary and significant efforts to care for those unable to care for themselves.

Born and raised in Virginia, Jim graduated with a BA from University of Virginia and an MBA from Columbia University. He is most proud of the two companies he and his business partner co-founded and subsequently sold after immense growth of each company (The Direct Company and Really Good Stuff). Most meaningful to Jim was enriching the education of students across the country initially focusing on Kindergartners and First Graders, then expanding to all grades. He felt a deep responsibility to also care and provide for the employees and families of his companies, always looking out for others.

A close family member instilled in Jim the importance of philanthropy and the responsibility this bears. He has always made the time to help others and maintained strong ties to his community. As a young father living in Westport, he was a member of the Family Center of Westport/Weston, and the Chair of the original Compo Beach Playground Project in 1989. Jim spearheaded the design and build of a much-needed community playground and after years of planning, along with over 1,500 people helping, built the playground in just five days. He also served on the United Way of Westport/Weston Board in the 1990's. Jim's journey with Mozaic Senior Life dates back to November 13, 2011. He was a client in our short-term rehabilitation on Jefferson Street. He will forever remember and appreciate the unparalleled care and compassion shown to him from the moment he arrived. As a grateful client, he began getting to know our organization and was very supportive of the concept of the new campus on Park Avenue. After he retired in 2016, his involvement grew as he shared his strong entrepreneurial experience and skills to help position Mozaic Senior Life to be financially secure and meet the core mission, as well as to grow and adapt in the challenging healthcare environment. Jim feels strongly that it is vitally important for Mozaic Senior Life to remain relevant. Jim is an active member of the Board of Directors, is the Founding Chairperson of the Vision 2031 Committee, as well as a member of the Audit, Finance, and Investment Committees.

Jim currently lives in Fairfield with his partner, Ellyn Myers. He previously lived in Westport for many years and has three adult children Rachel, Mike, and Sarah. Jim is an avid bicyclist and continues to ride 50-100 miles a week. Jim and Ellyn spend a few months a year in Naples, Florida where he volunteers with a non-profit organization that focuses on creating safe roads and paths for bicyclists.

LOUIS LOTSTEIN AWARD FOR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE

Joan A. Kuriansky

Joan A. Kuriansky, MA, JD, is this year's recipient of the Louis Lotstein Award for Distinguished Service. Her connection to Mozaic Senior Life began over 50 years ago through family. She is the daughter of one of the founding members of The Jewish Home for the Elderly of Fairfield County. Julius B. Kuriansky was the fifth Chairperson from 1978 to 1980. She continues to fulfill the legacy of the first generation of Kurianskys by supporting many organizations



through The Louis J. Kuriansky Foundation, and by personally being engaged at all levels in many Jewish and secular organizations, nationally and internationally. In addition to continuing her family's philanthropic engagement in charitable causes, she has followed a path of activism and advocacy, specifically for gender-based rights focused on developing and implementing policies and programs that have lasting impact on women's and girls' rights with issues surrounding aging, healthcare, economic self-sufficiency, and gender-based violence.

The Lotstein Award was created to recognize leaders for their long-term service to Mozaic Senior Life as demonstrated by the devotion of the late Louis Lotstein. This is a very fitting tribute to Joan, as Louis, also from the Stamford community, worked closely with her family as a visionary leader in the early years.

Joan has worked in the social justice field throughout her accomplished career as executive director, board member, and hands-on volunteer. She enjoys working with and mobilizing people and organizations to find innovative solutions like the first domestic violence courts in the country or a nationwide campaign on women's health to make an impact in the lives of women and families. As the Executive Director of a national aging organization, she addressed challenges that many Mozaic Senior Life clients face related

to long-term care, economic well-being, or caregiving. Joan is recognized for her leadership through various appointments and awards. President Clinton appointed Joan to the first National Advisory Council on Violence Against Women. She received a Gloria Steinem award where she was named "A Women of Vision" by the Ms. Foundation and most recently in 2020, received an award by Advocates for Human Rights for her research and advocacy in the field of gender-based violence.

Joan grew up in Stamford, graduated from Washington University, BA, Occidental College, MA, and University of Virgina Law School. She currently lives in Washington DC. Joan has a powerful voice and is a role model with tireless energy and unlimited knowledge, and is dedicated, persistent, and forever committed to ensuring women's and human rights for all, using her platform to effect change.

Our community has been enriched and we are so very grateful to Joan for making Mozaic Senior Life a priority in her life. Joan is committed to continuing the work of the generation that preceded her while bringing light to new issues, programs, and needs. Congratulations on this well-deserved award.

About our organization and our mission...

The overriding mission of the Women's Auxiliary is to nurture, enhance, and support quality of life initiatives for the Residents and clients that we serve. The Auxiliary fulfills this mission by augmenting services, programs, and facilities provided by Mozaic Senior Life. Our commitment to support ongoing programming especially throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, was a priority. With the strength and determination of this group of women, we are proud to say we found creative ways for the Residents to have special treats, small group programs, and larger gatherings.

The Women's Auxiliary undertook the challenge to create a place for seniors in our community in 1968. They were instrumental in building The Jewish Home for the Elderly of Fairfield County, now called Mozaic Senior Life, which opened 50 years ago on October 15, 1973. Hundreds of women have been involved as members of the Board of Directors during its existence. Thousands of women have been a part of our success through Auxiliary membership, volunteerism, and financially supporting and participating in our programs and events. It is through their dedication that the Auxiliary has raised over six million dollars to accomplish our mission. We are incredibly proud of our contributions and knowing that we make a daily difference in the lives of the Residents.

As part of celebrating 50 years of unparalleled care for Residents and clients, the organization rebranded as Mozaic Senior Life. The word mozaic was selected to convey that we are better, stronger, and more effective together. Each piece alone is beautiful, but when combined with other pieces, it is a representation of the beauty and diversity of the people who comprise our organization - Residents, clients, staff, and volunteers. In June 2016, Mozaic Senior Life opened The Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Campus on Park Avenue, our Household Model state-of-the-art intergenerational senior services campus which includes Mozaic Jewish Home our skilled nursing and rehabilitation, and Mozaic Assisted Living, our traditional assisted living, and memory care residences. This innovative environment is providing a rich social and cultural experience for seniors and has changed the concept of "nursing home" forever. A full range of services are provided to meet the needs of seniors in the community, including Mozaic Home Care,

Mozaic Hospice, Mozaic Adult Day, Mozaic at Home, Mozaic ElderCare Navigation, and Mozaic Adult Family Living. Also, the Mozaic Institute on Aging offers Geriatric Assessments and Care Management, and in response to an unfortunate but critical need, the Mozaic Center for Elder Abuse Prevention opened in 2007, the first in the state of Connecticut. Mozaic Concierge Living is our new Life Plan Community on Long Ridge Road in Stamford, currently in design and pre-marketing.

On behalf of the entire Women's Auxiliary, we would like to thank the Fall Gala Committee and Mozaic Senior Life staff. They have worked hard to coordinate this wonderful evening. Their energy and initiative are very much appreciated especially by all the Residents whose lives are enriched and enhanced by the funds we raise through this event. In the Beginning...

A Fairfield County Jewish Home for the Elderly didn't just happen. Behind the bricks and mortar were years of thinking, planning, sweat and tears. Conceived in 1965, this enormous project was brought to life by a prominent Bridgeport physician, Dr. Maurice Kaufman, and a real estate developer, Jerome S. Siebert.

In his practice, Dr. Kaufman was constantly confronted by Jewish elderly patients desperately in need of an

accommodation where they could live and receive care. Fairfield County had no such facility. Joined by Jerry Siebert, who shared his concern for the elderly, a movement was spearheaded to investigate the need for a Jewish Home to serve this geographic area. It soon became evident that the need was there and efforts began to meet the challenge.

Attorney David Goldstein agreed to become the Home's first President. With a tremendous knack for organization, key leaders from throughout Fairfield County were recruited. The project had been launched.

By 1967, the Jewish Home for the Elderly was incorporated. A site was purchased, Officers and a Board of Directors were elected, and installed, and architectural drawings were begun.

Efforts now turned to the Building Fund Campaign. There were early morning breakfasts, late dinners and meetings and long drives over icy roads to tell the story of the Home throughout the County. By 1969, the Building Committee was working long hours towards

finalizing construction plans. There were inspection trips and consultations at other Homes in the United States and Canada and meetings with healthcare professionals, architects, and builders.

The dream was finally becoming a reality. An enthusiastic crowd attended the Groundbreaking Ceremony on Sunday, October 3, 1971. Construction then began and the future looked bright.



By the Fall of 1972 with the Home one year into construction, a crisis loomed. Fundraising had slowed. Major contributors had already made substantial commitments to the Home, yet construction payments were quickly consuming pledge payments and bank loans were increasing precipitously. Invited to

an open house to review progress, Albert A. List came forward with an additional pledge and challenge gift which generated over \$1,000,000 in pledges!

The Dream Becomes A Reality...

On October 15, 1973, five Residents entered The Jewish Home and a tradition of service began. As Staff and Residents became acquainted, an individualized, problem-oriented system of care was being put into place. This system of care, which challenged staff to identify and resolve Residents' physical, social and emotional problems, was conceptualized and integrated into every professional discipline by Executive Director, Dennis J. Magid, Medical Director, Dr. Marvin Garrell, and Director of Nursing, Helen Churchill.




