ARTHUR AND GLADYS LUNIN HUMANITARIAN AWARD

Patti & Alan Masarek

Mozaic Senior Life is proud to present the Arthur and Gladys Lunin Humanitarian Award to Patti and Alan Masarek this evening, honoring their dedication to excellence within the entire community.

Described by Patti's family and friends as the most selfless person they have ever met, her life-long commitment to volunteerism and helping others has greatly influenced Alan over their 36-year marriage. Over the last several years, Patti has been intensively involved with The Center for Family Justice. Patti and Alan served as co-Chairs of the Empower House Project, dedicated to the building of a new domestic violence safe house that opens soon, aptly named 'Patti's Place'. Alan was heavily involved in the project's fundraising, and personally rode his bicycle across the United States, from the Pacific to the Atlantic Ocean, raising vital funds. She has also served as four-time tri-Chair of CFJ's event, "Speaking of Women," their largest annual fundraising event.

Patti's passion for helping others started at a young age, volunteering at a children's residential treatment center in her hometown of Columbus, OH. She earned her undergraduate Bachelor's Degree in Social Work from the University of Cincinnati, her Master's Degree in Social Work from New York University, and embarked on decades of working with at-risk communities. Patti started philanthropic organizations in her early years and later, worked at several social service agencies involved in domestic abuse, sexual violence, and adolescent case management.

Born in Miami, FL, Alan was raised in Atlanta, GA. He graduated from the University of Georgia, and earned his Master of Business Administration from Harvard Business School. Alan's business background spans 40+ years across enterprise communications, information technology and business, and financial services. Alan serves as CEO and Board Director of Avaya Holdings, a global enterprise communications company where he is leading its business transformation. Prior to Avaya, Alan served as CEO of Vonage Holdings Corporation. Before Vonage, Alan served as Director, Chrome & Apps at Google, Inc., following Google's acquisition of his prior company, Quickoffice, Inc., in which Alan was co-founder and CEO.

The Lunin Award states that any individual who by his/her sacrifice, effort, and service to the Fairfield County Community deserves to be recognized and held up as an example for others to follow. Of special merit are those individuals who have furthered the cause of justice, fostered understanding between Jews and non-Jews, and made voluntary and significant



efforts to care for those unable to care for themselves. Mozaic Senior Life knows how lucky we are to have the Masareks as part of our extended family. Not only have they become involved with Mozaic Senior Life, they have been involved in many volunteer service initiatives, often funded through their family foundation, the Masarek Giving Fund, whose mandate is to support child health, welfare, and education, but often extends to other worthy causes. Organizations including local synagogues and chabads, Jewish Federations, Jewish Family Services, ADL; multiple local food banks including Nourish Bridgeport; direct educational grants to deserving children from disadvantaged backgrounds at the University of New Haven and elsewhere; Hole in the Wall Gang Camp; the Jeff Masarek Center for Behavioral Health; the Crohns and Colitis Foundation; and multiple mission trips to Israel supporting the IDF following October 7, have all benefitted from their kindness and incredible generosity.



Patti and Alan are proud parents of two adult children and a wonderful son-in-law, as well as loving grandparents to three amazing grandchildren, who refer to them as Gaga and Papa. They feel incredibly fortunate to spend lots of time with their family, including wonderful events and holidays in Florida and Connecticut, plus terrific vacation travel. They currently live in Milford, after raising their family and living in Weston for many years.

Patti and Alan are indeed pillars of our community. We are grateful to know them and congratulate them on this extremely well-deserved award.

LOUIS LOTSTEIN AWARD FOR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE

Dr. Kenneth Fine

Our very own Dr. Kenneth Fine is this year's recipient of the Louis Lotstein Award for Distinguished Service. This award was created to recognize leaders for their long-term service to Mozaic Senior Life as demonstrated by the devotion of the late Louis Lotstein. This is a very fitting tribute to Ken who has been embracing Residents, clients, families, caregivers and co-workers with the utmost respect, professionalism, sensitivity, and compassion offering extraordinary comprehensive medical care to those that Mozaic Senior Life serves. He joined our organization in August 2007, first as a primary care physician, then the Medical Director of the Institute on Aging and Center for Elder Abuse prevention, and finally in 2012 as the Chief Medical Officer.



Ken, born in Glasgow, Scotland, attended Dickinson College in PA for his undergraduate studies. He earned his medical degree from the Catholic University of Louvain in Belgium. Ken returned to the States for an internship at New York Medical College and a Residency at Beth Israel Medical Center in New York City. After working in emergency medicine for a number of years, he was recruited to join Columbia Presbyterian as the first Director of Emergency Services at the Presbyterian Hospital. He was also an original member of a newly formed Division of General medicine of which he was an Acting Co-director for 10 years and rose to the rank of Associate Clinical Professor of Medicine at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. After 17 years at Columbia, Ken assumed directorships of the emergency departments at St. Raphael Hospital in New Haven where he was on the faculty at the Yale School of Medicine as well as at Lincoln Medical and Mental Health Center in South Bronx where he was a faculty member at Weill-Cornell School of Medicine. His career in fast-paced emergency medicine coupled with working

in academic general internal medicine, helped him refine the skills needed for a comprehensive approach to caring for seniors.

Ken, and his wife, Marilyn, lived and raised their daughter in Weston. They now live in Fairfield close to their daughter, son-in-law, and three grandchildren.

As Ken retires at the end of this year, the Lotstein Award is a small token of our gratitude as we thank him for his enormous gifts of knowledge and expertise to the Mozaic Senior Life team. We hope he continues to fine tune his cooking skills, exercise vigorously with those weekend 5k runs, and find meaningful opportunities to volunteer with medical organizations, and perhaps even teach.

We thank Ken for his enormous and remarkable contributions to the entire Mozaic Senior Life organization and community. Congratulations on this well-deserved award.

About our organization and our mission...

The overriding mission of the Women's Auxiliary is to nurture, enhance, and support quality of life initiatives for the Residents and clients that we serve. The Auxiliary fulfills this mission by augmenting services, programs, and facilities provided by Mozaic Senior Life. Our commitment to support ongoing programming especially throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, was a priority. With the strength and determination of this group of women, we are proud to say we found creative ways for the Residents to have special treats, small group programs, and larger gatherings.

The Women's Auxiliary undertook the challenge to create a place for seniors in our community in 1968. They were instrumental in building The Jewish Home for the Elderly of Fairfield County, now called Mozaic Senior Life, which opened 51 years ago on October 15, 1973. Hundreds of women have been involved as members of the Board of Directors during its existence. Thousands of women have been a part of our success through Auxiliary membership, volunteerism, and financially supporting and participating in our programs and events. It is through their dedication that the Auxiliary has raised over six million dollars to accomplish our mission. We are incredibly proud of our contributions and knowing that we make a daily difference in the lives of the Residents and clients.

Last year, as we celebrated our 50th anniversary of providing unparalleled care for Residents and clients, the organization rebranded as Mozaic Senior Life. The word mozaic was selected to convey that we are better, stronger, and more effective together. Each piece alone is beautiful, but when combined with other pieces, it is a representation of the beauty and diversity of the people who comprise our organization – Residents, clients, staff, and volunteers. In June 2016,

Mozaic Senior Life opened The Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Campus on Park Avenue, our Household Model state-of-the-art intergenerational senior services campus which includes Mozaic Jewish Home our skilled nursing and rehabilitation, and Mozaic Assisted Living, our traditional assisted living, and memory care residences. This innovative environment is providing a rich social and cultural experience for seniors and has changed the concept of “nursing home” forever. A full range of services are provided to meet the needs of seniors in the community, including Mozaic Home Care, Mozaic Hospice, Mozaic Adult Day, Mozaic at Home, Mozaic ElderCare Navigation, and Mozaic Adult Family Living. Also, the Mozaic Institute on Aging offers Geriatric Assessments and Care Management, and in response to an unfortunate but critical need, the Mozaic Center for Elder Abuse Prevention opened in 2007, the first in the state of Connecticut. Mozaic Concierge Living is our new Life Plan Community on Long Ridge Road in Stamford, currently in design and pre-marketing.

On behalf of the entire Women's Auxiliary, we would like to thank the Fall Gala Committee and Mozaic Senior Life staff. They have worked hard to coordinate this wonderful evening. Their energy and initiative are very much appreciated especially by all the Residents whose lives are enriched and enhanced by the funds we raise through this event. We would also like to thank all members of the Women's Auxiliary who we will rely on for help, support, and involvement to achieve our collective goals.
