

Title VI Policy Statement

Mozaic Senior Life is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participating, denied benefits, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity, on the basis of race, color, or national origin. Mozaic Senior Life, as a recipient of federal financial assistance, will ensure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended and related statutes and regulations in all Mozaic Senior Life programs and activities. Any person who believes that he or she has been subjected to discrimination or retaliation based on their race, color or national origin may file a Title VI complaint. Complaints may be filed directly to Mozaic Senior Life or to the Federal Funding Agency. Complaints must be made in writing and signed by the complainant or a representative and should include the complainant's name, address, and telephone number or other means by which the complainant can be contacted. Complaints must be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act.
